Here is the latest information from the school district regarding re-entry planning for the 2020-2021 school year.

Our hope is to start school as normal with precautionary measures in place; however, we plan to make a final decision by <u>Friday</u>, <u>July 24th</u> so that parents/guardians, students, and staff can have time to prepare and make plans for the beginning of school. Of course, any and all plans are subject to change depending upon the current state of affairs in our country, state, county, and city.

The District is preparing for multiple scenarios not only for the beginning of school scheduled for August 26, 2020, but for the entire school year.

These plans include:

A. Beginning school normally with students and staff in schools (with additional precautions in place)

- B. A combination of in-school and online learning
- C. Virtual/online education exclusively

The details of each plan/option will be shared by <u>July 24th, 2020</u>. Again, at this time, we do not know what to expect, but we have to be prepared for multiple scenarios.

The district has formed three committees to prepare and plan for re-entry. These committees are:

- 1. Curriculum & Instruction
- 2. Social & Emotional
- 3. Facilities & Safety

Each of these committees has representation from the school district including teachers, counselors, social workers, and administration. Parents and community members are also represented on each committee.
