Based upon the public health emergency order issued by the Johnson County Community Health Services on March 19, 2020 (<a href="http://johnsoncountyhealth.org/news/">http://johnsoncountyhealth.org/news/</a>), and the mandatory order issued by Jackson County Missouri (we have many staff members that reside in Jackson County), the Warrensburg R-VI School District will be extending school closure until <a href="https://example.com/april 24, 2020">April 24, 2020</a>. The previous closure was through April 3, 2020.

Meals (breakfast and lunch) for all children ages 0-18 will continue to be distributed by our Food Services personnel at Sterling, Reese, Martin Warren, Maple Grove, and the high school. You do not have to pick-up meals at the school your child attends.

As most of you are probably aware, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education has cancelled all state assessments (MAP, EOC) for this year, and we will <u>not</u> be required to make-up any lost school days due to COVID-19. When we receive any additional information, we will keep everyone updated.
